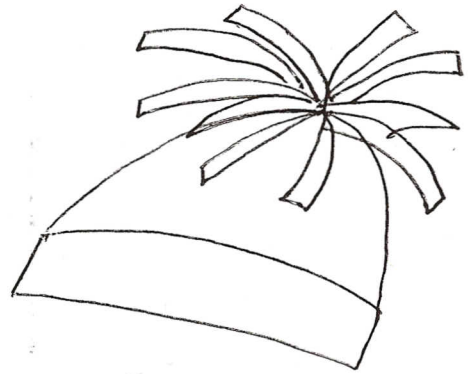


CAR WASH CAP



MATERIALS (will make two caps)

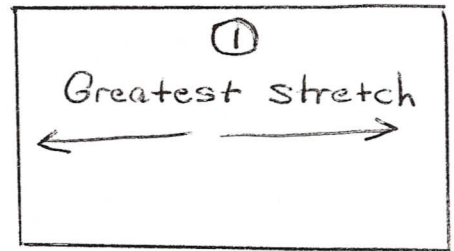
- For size small (Child size 4-8) = $\frac{1}{2}$ yard fleece
- For size medium (Child size 10-12) = $\frac{5}{8}$ yard fleece
- For size large (teen/adult) - $\frac{5}{8}$ yard fleece
- Thread to match (dark grey works well with most colors)

DIRECTIONS $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance:

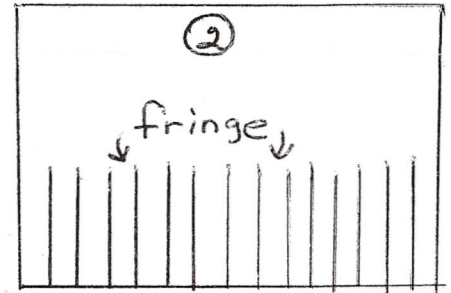
1. Cut for each cap.

NOTE: The longer dimension for the piece should run with the greatest stretch of the fabric!!

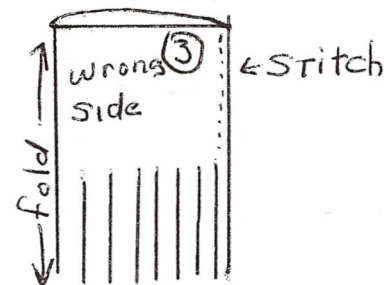
- Size small - (1) 17" X 18" piece and a strip 1" X 14"
 Size medium - (1) 19" X 20" piece and a strip 1" X 15"
 Size large - (1) 21" X 22" piece and a strip 1" X 15"



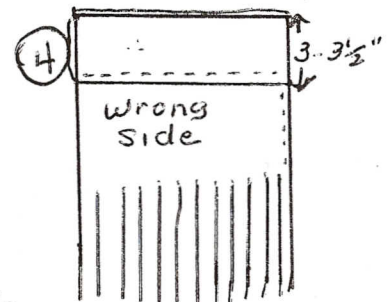
2. Cut 1" wide fringe along the longest edge on one side of the fleece. The depth of the fringe should be $4\frac{1}{2}$ " - 6" depending on cap size and personal preference.



3. Right sides together, stitch the short edges of the cap together. This forms a "tube" with fringe on one end.



4. Fold up (3" for small and medium, and $3\frac{1}{2}$ " for large size) bottom edge of the cap to the inside (wrong side). Stitch $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the cut edge of the fabric.



5. Turn cap to the right side. Tie tightly the 1" strip around the fringe, pulling the fringe together. Fold bottom up to form a cuff for extra warmth around the ears.
